Summary: A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued on February 25, 2026, to select a qualified firm for Debris Management and Removal. Eight responsive proposals were received and reviewed by an Advisory Committee comprised of the following individuals:

Based on the information presented in the proposals and the evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP, the firms were ranked by the Advisory Committee in the following order:

The initial contract term is three years with an option to renew for three additional one-year terms. The Advisory Committee recommends awarding to the top for ranked firms.

"Enhance the quality of life in the City by delivering public services in a knowledgeable, responsive and financially responsible manner."

The Contractors will provide the designated services, including operations and management, logistical support, construction and technical assistance, before, during, or after any potential or actual disaster situations, including, but not limited to tornados, hurricanes, severe weather events, or any other disasters or emergencies. The fiscal impact of the proposed Contracts is currently unknown and is dependent upon whether an actual emergency event or natural disaster occurs. As a result, no funds are committed on the attached Fiscal Impact Statement.

Recommended Action: Approve the ranking established by the Advisory Committee and approve and authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to negotiate and execute a contract and subsequent renewals with the top four ranked firms, Ashbritt, Inc, Phillips Environmental, LLC, Southern Disaster Recovery, and DRC Emergency Services, as indicated. If negotiations are not successful with the top ranked firms, approve and authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to negotiate with the remaining firms in ranked order and execute a contract and subsequent renewals as indicated, with the highest four ranked firms with whom agreement is reached. The final negotiated agreements will be subject to review and approval by the City Attorney's Office.
