Summary: The Orlando Police Department Ranch Unit is tasked with policing and supporting newly acquired, large, rural, and rapidly developing areas in the southern region of the City of Orlando. This area includes farmland, undeveloped property, construction zones, and environmentally sensitive terrain that is not readily accessible by standard patrol vehicles.

The Chief of Police is requests approval to use \$41,676.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the acquisition of a Polaris Ranger Utility Vehicle. The Polaris Ranger will significantly enhance the Ranch Unit's ability to patrol remote areas, respond quickly to incidents, and conduct proactive enforcement in locations that are otherwise difficult to access.

Recommended Action: Approve Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETf) expenditure of \$41,676.00 for the purchase of a Polaris Ranger Utility Vehicle, and authorize the Chief of Police to execute same, certifying that the LETf expenditure complies with Florida Statute 932.7055, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney's Office.
