SUBJECT: Piggyback Contract with Uretek and the City of St. Petersburg FL, for Soil Stabilization Services throughout the City.

The Streets and Stormwater Division is interested in obtaining Uretek for a piggyback contract for soil stabilization work throughout the City addressing our current needs and any future work that may arise within the City. The work would include: subterranean injection of single or multi-part polyurethane materials to fill voids or stabilize and/or strengthen in-situ soils; subterranean injections of chemical, cementitious, or other grout material to fill voids or stabilize and/or strengthen in-situ soils; and provide subterranean injections of acrylic, polyurethane, epoxy or cementitious material to stabilize and/or seal structures and pipes. Uretek currently has a contract with the City of St. Petersburg (RFQ25-097), for trenchless soil stabilization with competitive pricing that would be beneficial to the City. The contract has a term of three (3) years with the option to renew it for one (1) additional 2-year term.
