

**Title: Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement and Resolution for Construction of the Edgewater Drive Complete Streets Project Segment A**

**Summary:** The City of Orlando Transportation Department is seeking to enter a Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to receive grant funding for costs associated with the construction phase of the Edgewater Drive Complete Streets Segment A project (FPN 441275-2-58-01).

The project limits along Edgewater Drive extend from approximately 200 feet south of Lakeview Street to 100 feet north of Lake Adair Boulevard (with a segment of approximately 200 feet along Lakeview Street) for an approximate total project length of 930 feet (0.176 miles).

The proposed improvements include construction of a new single-lane asphalt roundabout at the intersection of Edgewater Drive and Lakeview Street including truck apron, milling and resurfacing, concrete pavement, patterned pavement, brick pavers, raised crosswalks, sidewalk, detectable warnings, curb and gutter, directional medians, landscaping, signing and pavement markings, drainage improvements, and lighting improvements (including but not limited to, conduit and pull and splice boxes). Steel sheet pile retaining wall and concrete traffic railing barrier, raised sidewalk with pedestrian/bicycle railing will also be constructed on the Lake Adair side.

This Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement is to receive reimbursement of grant funding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) through the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the amount of \$ \$2,970,360. All ineligible and uncovered costs will be covered by local agencies.

**Recommended Action:** Approve Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement and Corresponding Resolution and authorize Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem and City Clerk to execute the same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney's Office.

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
