

**Title: City Hall Use Application and Contract for June 6, 2026,
CommUNITY Rainbow Run**

Summary: The City of Orlando is hosting the 10th Annual CommUNITY Rainbow Run which is a community event to honor and remember the 49 lives that were taken in the Pulse tragedy and show support for their families, the survivors, and everyone impacted.

The event will start and end with a community festival hosted in the City Commons Plaza. The VIP Event will be hosted in the City Hall Rotunda. Net proceeds for this event will benefit the Orlando United Pulse Memorial, a project within Strengthen Orlando, the City's 501c (3) to construct a permanent memorial at the Pulse site.

Attendance for the run and festival is expected to be 2000 people, with attendance for the open - house style VIP Event expected to be 200 people.

City Council permission is sought to allow these events in the City Commons Plaza and City Hall Rotunda, which is not normally used for fundraising events.

The corresponding Special Event Permit has been included on the Special Event Permits for Outdoor Parks and Outdoor Public Assemblies Item submitted and approved at the April 20, 2026, City Council meeting under the Transportation section of the agenda.

Recommended Action: Approve the City Hall Use Application and Contract and authorize the City Clerk to issue the contract for the June 6, 2026, CommUNITY Rainbow Run, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney's Office.
